Overall	1	The manuscript is unpublished and free of misconduct as defined in "Ethical Guidelines" in "Instructions for Authors."	
	2	The manuscript is prepared using the specified template.	
	3	All co-authors have agreed to take responsibility for all statements in the paper.	
Title	4	The title accurately reflects the contents and characteristics of the paper.	
Abstract	5	The word count of the abstract is within the specified limit (refer to Table 1 of "Instructions to Authors").	
Keyword	6	Approximately five keywords or phrases that accurately describe the paper have been selected.	
	7	Keywords are written as singular nouns in lowercase (except for proper nouns).	
	8	Nuclide names are written in full English (e.g., caesium-137), not as element symbols.	
	9	Abbreviations are spelled out followed by the abbreviation in parentheses. Example: positron emission tomography (PET).	
Text	10	There are no omissions or typographical errors, and all units are in SI.	
	11	For element symbols with mass numbers, the mass number is placed as a superscript to the left. Example: ^{137}Cs	
	12	The numbering of figures, tables, and formulas in the text is correct.	
	13	All in-text citations match the reference list, with no discrepancies or omissions.	
	14	Explanations for all figures and tables are provided within the text.	
	15	Abbreviations are spelled out in full upon first mention in the text. Example: Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station (FDNPS) Accident.	
Figures	16	Figure captions and descriptions are placed below the figure; table captions are above, and table descriptions are below.	

	17	The desired insertion positions for figures and tables are specified in the text.	
	18	Permission has been obtained from the copyright holder to reprint figures or tables.	
	19	Figures are submitted as PDF or image files, and tables as Word or PowerPoint files, separate from the main text.	
Reference	20	References are formatted according to the "Notes for Manuscript Preparation."	
	21	For references with more than five authors, the first four are listed, followed by "et al."	
English	22	The author has confirmed that the English grammar in the manuscript is correct.
